Aurora, Nebraska February 23, 2016

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Aurora, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:30 p.m. on February 23, 2016 at the City Hall. Present were Councilors: Paul Lackore, Daniel Bartling, Dorothy Anderson and Kelly Grossnicklaus. Mayor David Long conducted the meeting. City Officials present were City Administrator Eric Melcher, City Attorney Ross Luzum, Chief of Police Paul Graham, Utility Superintendent Adam Darbro and Clerk/Treasurer Barbra Mikkelsen.

Notice of said meeting was given by publication in the Aurora News Register on February 3, 2016. Notice of meeting was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda of this meeting was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Long opened the duly advertised public hearing to receive public comments on the recommendation of the Planning Commission to approve the request from ADC on behalf of T & M Incorporated to approve a Preliminary Plat of Regier Subdivision, an addition to the City of Aurora, Hamilton County, Nebraska, a part of the West Half (1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (1/4), of Section Twenty-Two (22), Township Ten (10) North, Range Six (6) West of the 6th P.M., Hamilton County, Nebraska.

The Mayor asked if there was anyone present who wished to speak in favor of the proposed recommendation. Bill Hunter President of ADC spoke in favor of the recommendation. The Mayor then asked if there was anyone present who wished to speak in opposition to the proposed recommendation. RESOLUTION NO. 16-02

WHEREAS, the Aurora Planning Commission and the Aurora City Council have held public hearings to receive public input regarding the preliminary plat and the final plat of Regier Subdivision, an addition to the City of Aurora, Hamilton County, Nebraska, a part of the West Half (W1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4), of Section Twenty-Two (22), Township Ten (10) North, Range Six (6) West of the 6th P.M., Hamilton County, Nebraska, said area containing approximately 20.575 acres more or less; and have held separate public hearings to consider whether the Subdivision should be included within the Corporate limits of the City of Aurora, and

WHEREAS, said plat of Regier Subdivision meets the requirements of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Aurora, and the Statutes of the State of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the Aurora Planning Commission has recommended to the City Council approval of the final plat to be known as Regier Subdivision and has recommended that it be included within the Corporate limits, and the City Council on this date has voted for approval of this Subdivision; and has voted to include this Subdivision within the City Limits.
