Household hazardous waste facility open weekdays

The Grand Island Clean Community System has announced its facility for proper disposal of household hazardous waste is available to all residents of Aurora and rural Hamilton County on all weekdays from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The household hazardous waste site is at 3661 Sky Park Road, Suite 2B, Grand Island. It is two blocks south of the terminal building for the Central Nebraska Regional Airport on the east side of the road.

Those who wish to bring household

hazardous waste to the facility must call ahead during the work week and set an appointment to be sure a staff member is available.

The facility is also open on the first and third Saturday of each month from 8 a.m. to noon, and no appointment is necessary.

Household hazardous waste is any substance containing ingredients which could negatively affect the environment or human health and safety. Alerting words found on the products include danger, warning, caution,

toxic, flammable, corrosive, explosive, reactive, irritant and poison. They can be found on a wide range of products found in and around the home.

Electronics are also accepted for recycling at the following fees: computer monitors, \$12 each; fluorescent bulbs, \$0.50 each; TVs and all other electronics, \$0.30 per pound.

Also available is a reusable products area which contains many useful household products either unopened or 3/4 full, available at no cost with a "buy none, get one free" policy.
