

JOB TITLE: RECREATION SUMMER LABORER

ACCOUNTABILITY: Under the direction of the Parks & Recreation Superintendent.

JOB SUMMARY: Under supervision, performs most operations involved in the maintenance and preparation of athletic fields for games during baseball/softball season and park properties and facilities.

GENERAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: Assist higher level workers in care and maintenance of recreation facilities, grounds, and equipment including, but not limited to, mowing, raking, watering, edging, and cleaning of walks, and removal of litter; operates and maintains various equipment; including power mowers, weed trimmers, edgers, and small tractors with grounds maintenance equipment attachments; drags fields, measures distances, and marks fields to exact specifications; assists with weed and pest control applications as required; maintenance of park grounds, buildings, and restrooms; performs related work as required.

SKILLS & ABILITIES: Ability to work in all types of weather conditions; ability to lift 50 lb. bags of seed, fertilizer, or marking chalk; ability to carry, push, or pull a variety of tools, equipment, and materials used in maintenance of athletic fields; ability to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, and work in crouched position; ability to perform mowing and weed trimming duties.

TRAINING & EXPERIENCE: Graduation from high school and some experience as a laborer, maintenance worker of grounds, buildings, or other facilities, or any equivalent combination of education and experience.
