A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Aurora, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:30 p.m. on February 26, 2019 at the City Hall. Present were Councilors: Paul Lackore, Daniel Bartling, Dorothy Anderson, Dick Phillips and Nancy Lohrmeyer. Mayor Marlin Seeman conducted the meeting. City Officials present were City Administrator Eric Melcher, City Attorney Ross Luzum, Chief of Police Paul Graham and Clerk/Treasurer Barbra Mikkelsen.

Notice of said meeting was given by publication in the Aurora News Register on February 20, 2019. Notice of meeting was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda of this meeting was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

**MINUTES:**

**PETITIONS, COMPLAINTS, COMMUNICATIONS:**

Charles McGraw of Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska-RYDE Transit reviewed the budget request for 2019-2020 for the public transportation service in Hamilton County. The request is for the \$9,550.00. Councilor Phillips moved to approve Resolution 19-03 instructing Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska-RYDE Transit to apply for federal funds and to provide for local funding match of \$9,550.00. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bartling, Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer and Lackore. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Roblee. The motion carried and the following resolution was declared passed and adopted.

RESOLUTION 19-03

WHEREAS, there are Federal funds available under Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act and for the Nebraska Public Transportation Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, the RYDE Transit-Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska desires to apply for said funds to provide public transportation in Hamilton County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Aurora hereby instructs the RYDE Transit to apply for said funds.

Said funds are to be used for the RYDE Transit transportation operations in Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Application for Public Transportation Assistance.


