- Have a Master Plumber's License from a larger City that the Aurora Water/Sewer Commissioner approves.

- Include a Surety Bond in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

All applicants must be approved at a regular Council Meeting.

ORDINANCE 10-302 SURETY BOND: Each person, firm or corporation shall be required to provide the Municipality with a personal surety bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) signed by one or more sufficient sureties or a bond in a like amount from an approved corporate surety. The bond shall be conditioned that the licensee shall indemnify and hold harmless the City from all accidents, damage, liability, claims, judgments, costs, or expense caused by any negligence arising from a failure to adequately protect plumbing work, by unfinished, unskilled, or inadequate work or arising out of furnishing defective material.
