

Aurora, Nebraska
March 24, 2020

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Aurora, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:30 p.m. on March 24, 2020 at the City Hall. Present were Councilors: Paul Lackore, Wayne Roblee, Daniel Bartling, Dorothy Anderson, Dick Phillips and Nancy Lohrmeyer. Mayor Marlin Seeman conducted the meeting. City Officials present were City Administrator Eric Melcher, City Attorney Ross Luzum, Chief of Police Paul Graham, Utilities Superintendent Adam Darbro and Clerk/Treasurer Barbra Mikkelsen.

Notice of said meeting was given by publication in the Aurora News Register on March 18, 2020. Notice of meeting was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda of this meeting was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

MINUTES:

Councilor Lackore moved to approve the minutes from the March 10, 2020 meeting. Councilor Lohrmeyer seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Roblee, Bartling, Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer and Lackore. Nay: None. The motion carried.

PETITIONS, COMPLAINTS, COMMUNICATIONS:

Michael Hoback of AMGL, P.C. presented the audit of the City's financial statements for Fiscal Year 2018-2019. Councilor Phillips moved to accept the audit of the City's financial statement for Fiscal Year 2018-2019. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bartling, Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer, Lackore and Roblee. Nay: None. The motion carried.

Central District Health Department was unable to attend the meeting to give an update on the Corona Virus Pandemic, agenda item #5 was not done.

Councilor Phillips moved to approve Resolution 20-04 setting sanitation rates and landfill fees. Councilor Roblee seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer, Lackore, Roblee and Bartling. Nay: None. The motion carried and the following resolution was declared passed and adopted.

RESOLUTION 20-04

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Nebraska, provides garbage collection services to domestic and commercial residents of the City.

AND WHEREAS, Section 91.06 of the Municipal Code of the City of Aurora provides that fees for such service shall be established by resolution of its Council.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL that the following fees shall be assessed for such service:

RATES FOR 2020

A. Service with Toter. Residential or business establishments shall be charged for each residential unit or business establishment \$11.95 per month for one toter one pickup each week plus \$3.15 for each additional toter. Each additional weekly pickup is an additional \$8.70 per month plus \$3.15 for each additional toter picked up.

B. Service with 2-Yard Containers. Customers utilizing 2-yard containers shall be charged 43.51 per month for each pickup per week, plus \$9.78 per month container rental.

Bills not paid by the tenth of the month, following billing, will be subject to the above rates plus a ten- percent (10%) service charge.

RATES FOR 2021

A. Service with Toter. Residential or business establishments shall be charged for each residential unit or business establishment \$12.50 per month for one toter one pickup each week plus \$3.30 for each additional toter. Each additional weekly pickup is an additional \$9.10 per month plus \$3.30 for each additional toter picked up.

B. Service with 2-Yard Containers. Customers utilizing 2-yard containers shall be charged 45.50 per month for each pickup per week, plus \$10.25 per month container rental.

Bills not paid by the tenth of the month, following billing, will be subject to the above rates plus a ten- percent (10%) service charge.

Service at the Old Landfill

To accommodate City residents with items which are not collected from residences or commercial pickup points, the City provides a roll-off container at the old landfill at the following rates:
