A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Aurora, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:30 p.m. on July 26, 2022 at the City Hall. Present were Councilors: Paul Lackore, Daniel Bartling, Dick Phillips and Nancy Lohrmeyer. Mayor Marlin Seeman conducted the meeting. City Officials present were City Administrator Eric Melcher, City Attorney Ross Luzum, Chief of Police Paul Graham and Clerk/Treasurer Barbra Mikkelsen.

Notice of meeting was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Councilor Phillips seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Lohrmeyer, Lackore, Bartling and Phillips. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Roblee and Dunn. The motion carried.
